



## Cell Biologist

We invite applications for a tenure-track faculty position at the Assistant Professor rank, although an appointment at a higher rank may be considered under special circumstances. Applicants should have post-doctoral experience and a demonstrable record of research success in the field of Cell Biology; a Ph.D. degree is required. Applicants will be evaluated on their research accomplishments, including publications, the quality and significance of these accomplishments, their demonstrated ability or potential for success in attracting external funding, and their experience and enthusiasm toward participating in the undergraduate teaching mission of the Department.

The Biology Department faculty (<http://www.biology.emory.edu/>) are well-funded, productive, and actively engaged in the research and teaching missions of Emory University, a top 20 research university located on the periphery of Atlanta, one of the United States' most vibrant cities. This position provides access to state-of-the-art facilities, resources and academic interactions with over 300 faculty engaged in biological research at Emory University and neighboring institutions.

Applicants should submit a single PDF file composed of: 1. cover letter; 2. CV; 3. a description of their research experience, interests, proposed projects and goals for their independent, externally funded laboratory; and 4. a statement of their teaching experience, interests, and philosophy.
